If someone collapses and becomes unresponsive:

Step 1

**Call
9-1-1**



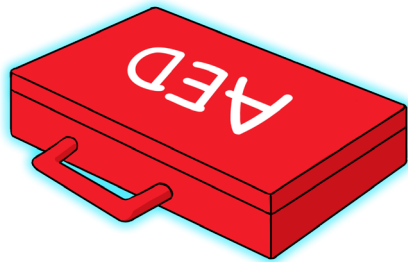
Step 2

Start CPR
Push hard and fast in the center of the chest



Step 3

Send for AED
Open the AED and press the on/off button



Step 4

Listen
Follow voice instructions and prompts
